A Committee for facilitation of compliance of Implementation of order/judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Special Leave to Appeal bearing no. 4401-4402/2019 was constituted vide No.WII/ADM/2022/58 dated 05.12.2022. The second meeting of the committee held on 26.12.2022. The following were present:





Now the committee is of opinion that:


- (i) Firstly, the joining and regularization of the petitioners is to be done within 10 weeks from the orders of the honorable court. The proposal already approved by the competent authority i.e. Secretary /Chairperson WII Governing Body, needs to be implemented urgently on the basis of letter dated 17.10.2017.
- (ii) Appointment letters may be issued to petitioners in regular position w.e.f. 31.10.2018 i.e. from the date of High Court verdict.
- (iii) It was observed that in few cases essential qualification was either not met or met partially. However, offer of regularization may be given to comply court verdict as per the letter dated 17.10.2017.
- (iv) As the honorable court has directed "to regularize the services of petitioners taking into consideration the length of the service on the basis of letter dated 17.10.2017 " hence for settlement of related issues on the case to case basis, the committee will meet again. Committee is also of view to include an external member having experience in the field of administration, in next meetings.
